Nominations are now open for the 2019 BC Health Care Awards. Presented by the Health Employers Association of BC (HEABC), the awards celebrate excellence and innovation in BC health care, and recognize people and teams who provide outstanding care and support.

More than 220 Gold Apples and Awards of Merit have been awarded to health care employees over the past 12 years, including front line professionals and those who work behind the scenes.

Awards are for projects improving health care delivery and for individuals making a positive impact and inspiring those around them. Award categories are: Top Innovation, Workplace Health Innovation, Collaborative Solutions, Dianna Mah-Jones Award of Excellence in Person-Centred Care and Health Care Heroes (8 awards in total).
